### Results of Leaders' Guide Survey

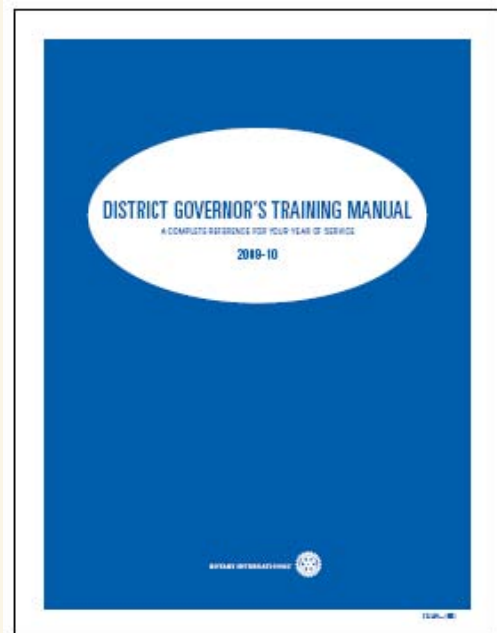
Thank you to those who responded to our survey on RI leaders' guides. The survey has resulted in following findings:

- 76% of the respondents use Rotary International training publications.
- 77% of those respondents modify the content of training publications, typically by including relevant district examples.
- The most commonly used training method among respondents is facilitated discussion.
